SARGON of AKKAD



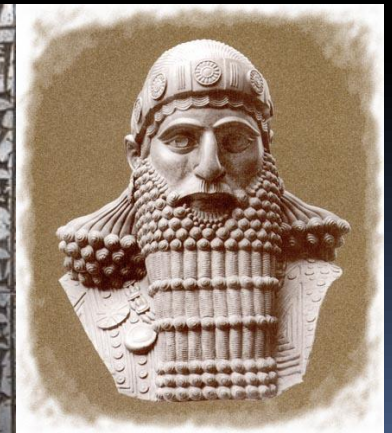
1792 - 1750 BCE

enslaved by Egyptians

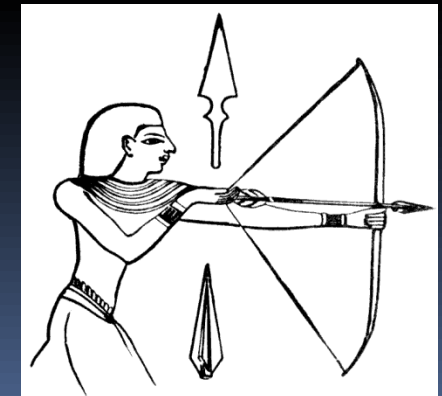
HEBREWS

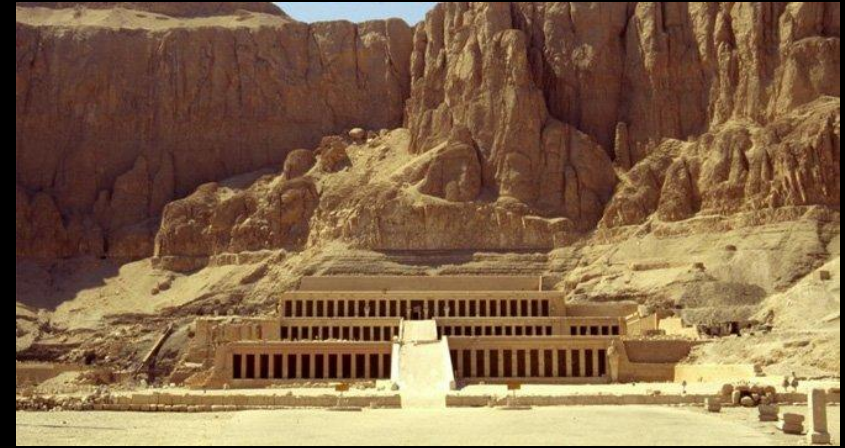

Locations of New Tombs and Temples

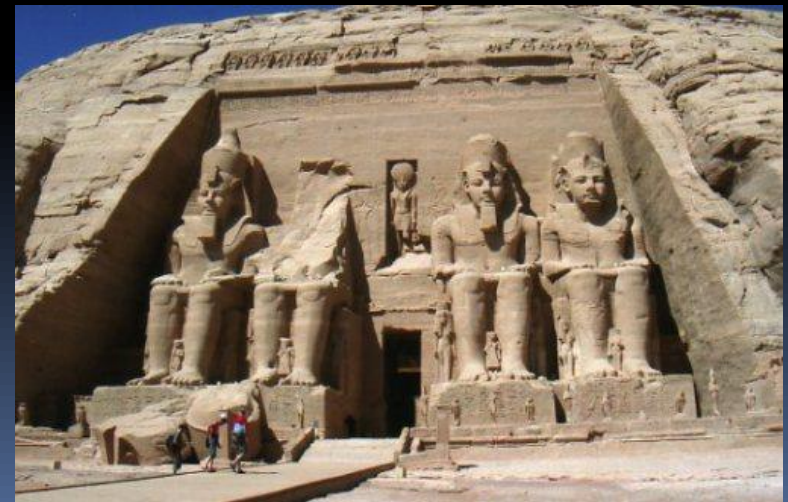
Tombs near Thebes:

LOCATED AT KARNAK



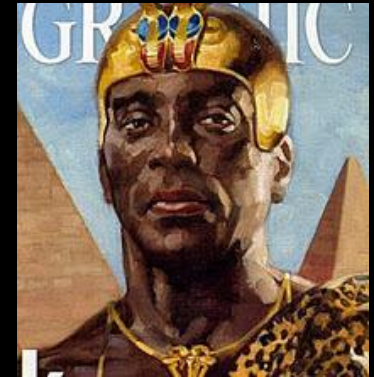

The Assyrian Empire

704 - 681 BCE

This Ruler destroyed Babylon & ordered its inhabitants killed

SENNACHERIB

Assyrian treatment of their victims

1. KILLED THEM
2. ENSLAVED THEM
3. EXPELLED THEM

Assyrian methods of governing

1. CENTRAL AUTHORITY
2. LOCAL GOVERNORS
3. MILITARY POWER

CHALDEANS



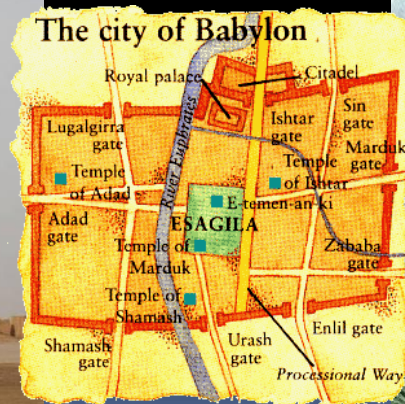
604 - 562 BCE

The Persian Empire

576 - 530 BCE

This Ruler founded the Persian Empire

CYRUS the GREAT

His most enduring legacy was the treatment of the people his Empire conquered

1. Kindness & Tolerance
2. Prevented Looting
3. Honored Customs



522 - 485 BCE

This ruler seized power using his "Ten Thousand Immortals"

DARIUS the GREAT

His real genius lay in his Administration of the Persian Empire

Divided into: 20 PROVINCES
Local Governors: SATRAPS
Important Route: ROYAL ROAD
