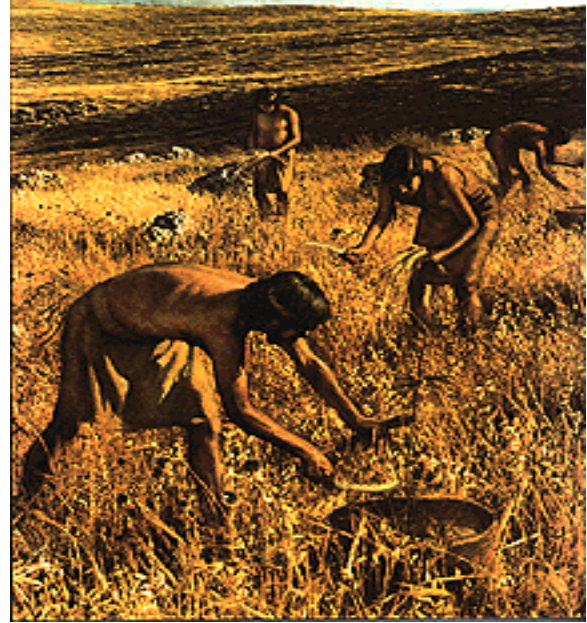


Early Human Vocabulary



- 1. Neolithic Era:** The new stone age – after the Paleolithic Era. One of the major changes as early humans moved from the Paleolithic to the Neolithic Era was the advent of ‘Agriculture’.
- 2. Agriculture:** Farming and herding. No longer relying on Hunting and Gathering, but actually planting and cultivation crops, and corralling animals.
- 3. Domestication:** The act of taming crops and animals - planting and cultivation crops, and penning up, taking care of animals.
- 4. Specialization:** As agriculture increased and improved, less people were need to tend the crops and animals. People then began doing other things needed in the community. These things turned into jobs, and people began to specialize, or become very good, at certain things. This became known as ‘Specialization of labor’.
