

**Theocracy** Religious Leaders hold power. Laws and government are based on

religious teachings.

**Democracy** Citizens vote.

<u>Direct Democracy</u> - All eligible citizens participate in government and make laws.

<u>Republic</u> (Representative Democracy – Citizens elect representatives who make and enforce laws – doing the work of the government.

**Monarchy** King or Queen is head of state.

Absolute Monarchy – a monarch, by birth, governs with total power.

<u>Constitutional Monarchy</u> – a monarch holds limited power. An elected legislature runs the government.

**Dictatorship** A supreme leader governs with absolute power.
